**PartB. CV SUMMARY (max. 3500 characters, including spaces)**

Based on the experience and opportunity provided through a Collaboration Grant (MEC) for the last year of the undergraduate degree (1995-1996) we have decided to continue with the historical research. After completing the doctoral courses (1996-1998) in the 'Contemporary Studies' program offered by the USC, with the help of my director, Professor Ramón Villares, I have defined the research topic for the doctoral thesis in the figure of the Galician jurisconsult Eugenio Montero Ríos. In 1997 I was co-author of the book Parliamentary Speeches by Eugenio Montero Ríos no Democratic Sexenio (1868-1873) edited by the EGAP - Xunta de Galicia. Two years later, in 1999, we continued to delve into the figure of the jurisconsult with the publication of the second volume of the speeches, entitled Parliamentary Speeches of Montero Ríos na Restauración borbónica (1874-1923). The academic / research activity continued its course since then, participating in different competitive research projects. In 2001, once we discovered that the personal archive of our character under study had been destroyed, we have varied the research topic trying to address the study of the Galician 'cacique' within

the complex world of turnismo during the Restoration and as one more example of the clientelistic policies that were developing in the European liberal political culture during the transition from the 19th to the 20th century, the case of Italian trasformism and French opportunism. For this, in addition to the predoctoral and doctoral scholarships financed by the Xunta de Galicia (1998-2001), the Caja Madrid Foundation (2003) and the Secretary of State for Tourism and Commerce (2004), I have enjoyed research stays in Italy (financed by the Xunta de Galicia -2000- and by the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs AEI -2002-) and in France (financed by the French Embassy -2001-). This experience has allowed me to finish my Doctorate with a European mention in February 2005, for which I have obtained the Extraordinary Doctorate Award. During the 2004-2005 academic year I have completed a Master's Degree in European Union Studies at the University of A Coruña. The research report with which I have passed the same Master is entitled "Regionalism in the European Union. The Committee of the Regions (the Spanish Autonomous Communities)", which has allowed me to delve into the diversity and regional richness of the EU from a comparative perspective. In the postdoctoral stage I have continued with the study of clientelistic networks and politicization processes in Galicia during the first decades of the 20th century, always from the perspective compared to other European examples. For this I have had postdoctoral research stays financed by the Xunta de Galicia and USC at the Écoles des Hautes Études en Sciences Sociales in Paris (2005-2008) and at the Dipartimento di Discipline Storiche - Università di Bologna, Italy (2009). Among the most recent editions and co-editions would be the books Monarchy and liberalism in Spain. The building of the Nation-State, 1780-1931, Routledge, New York, 2021; Alfonso XIII visits Spain. Monarquía y Nation, Comares, Granada, 2016. In addition, there would also be articles in high-impact magazines such as Hispania (2019), Contemporary History (2015), Ler História (2015), Cahier de Civilization Espagnole Contemporaine (2013), etc. To the publications cited in this summary must be added the coordination / authorship of 13 more books, 58 book chapters, 16 articles, the presentation and defense of 41 communications / papers to national and international congresses, 3 conferences and the evaluation of articles (system double blind) for publication in scientific journals.
