Part C. RELEVANT MERITS (*sorted by typology*)

In general, these works carry out a review of the different changes and transformations carried out in Galician veterinary medicine and livestock during the first half of the 20th century. Thus, in the book "Juan Rof Codina: renovation in contemporary galician veterinary medicine", the biography of veterinarian Rof Codina is taken as the guiding thread and an analysis is made from a multidisciplinary point of view where the impact that the dissemination actions of the veterinary profession and in particular the pedagogical work of Rof Codina, had in the Galician livestock improvement.

In the same way, at work "Canto val una vaca? From the agrarian question to the livestock question in Galicia, the role of livestock as an engine and catalyst of agricultural innovation is vindicated, as well as the changes in the socio-economic environment of Galician agriculture during the first half of the 20th century, placing these in a context of transformations that in the same sense is taking place in Atlantic Europe.
